

SNAKE AWARENESS PROGRAMME at ICAR NAARM on 3rd March 2020

Prakriti Club of PGDMA, ICAR-NAARM has conducted “Snake Awareness Programme” on 03rd March 2020 on the occasion of **World Wildlife Day 2020**. This awareness program was organized in collaboration with the NGO - Friends of Snakes Society, Hyderabad.



This awareness program provided insights about how to distinguish between venomous and non-venomous snakes, identification of types of snakes commonly found in Telangana, first aid for snake bite, common myths about snakes, etc. Around 11 species of snakes which includes Spectacle Cobra, Russel Viper, Rat Snake, Sand

Boa, etc. were brought and showed to the audience.

About 100 numbers of students of PGDMA programme, faculty and all staff members of NAARM have attended the programme.
