

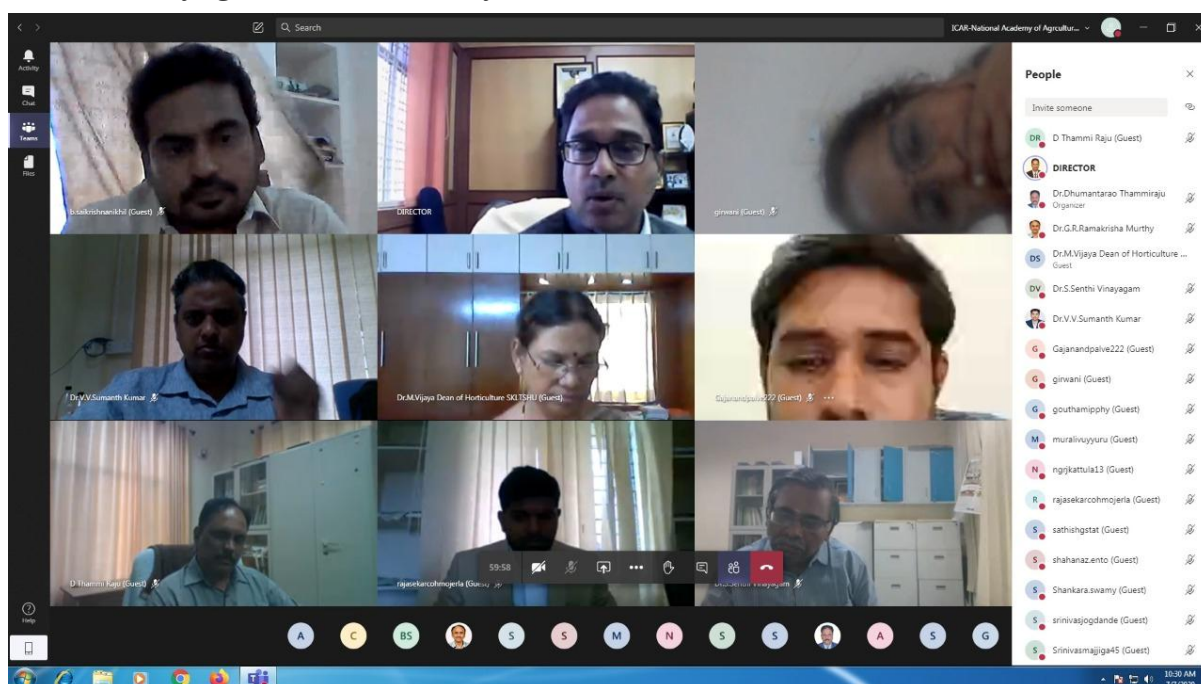
Competency Enhancement for Young Faculty of SKLTS Horticulture University by ICAR-NAARM

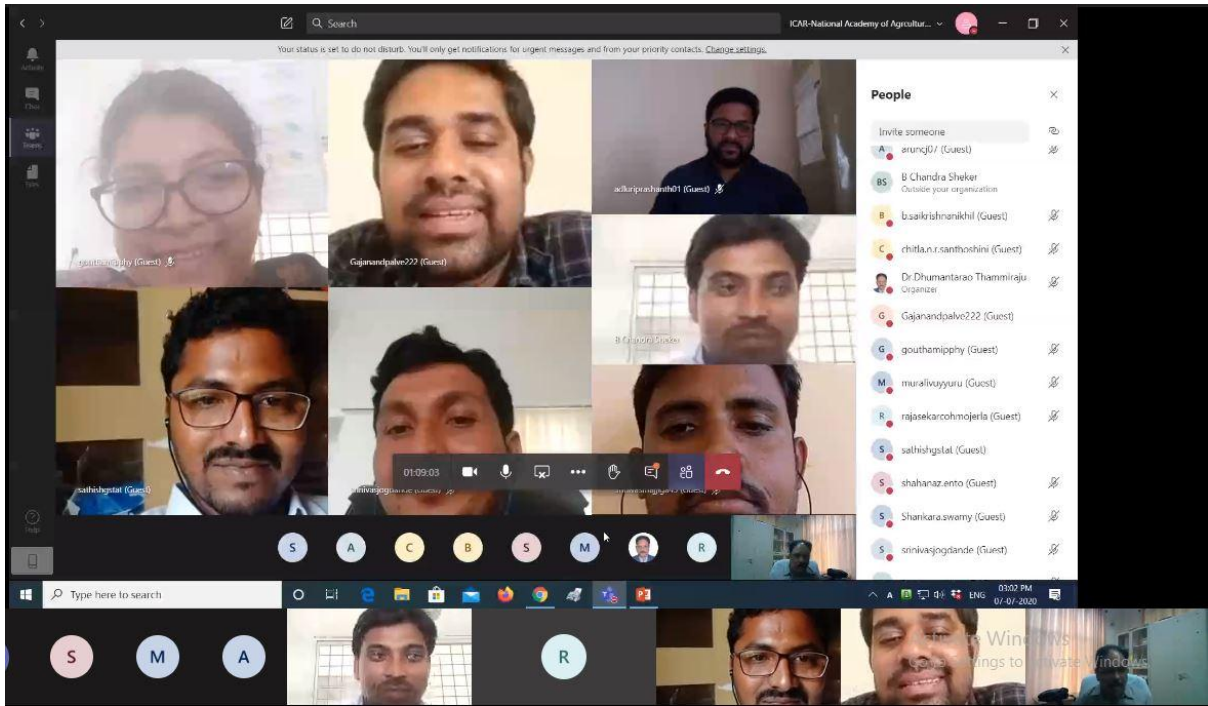

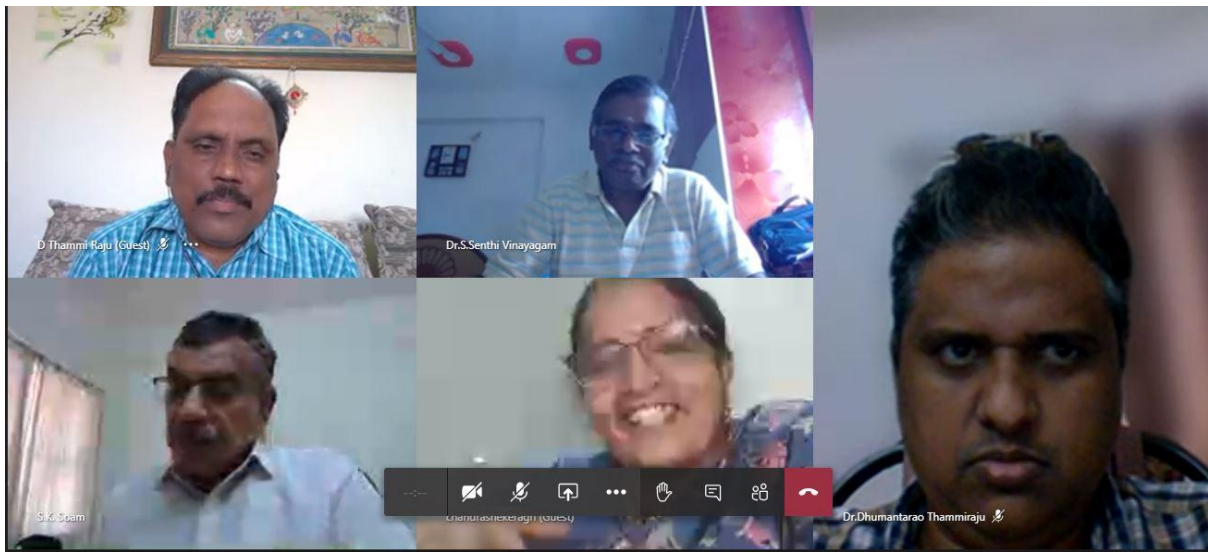
