

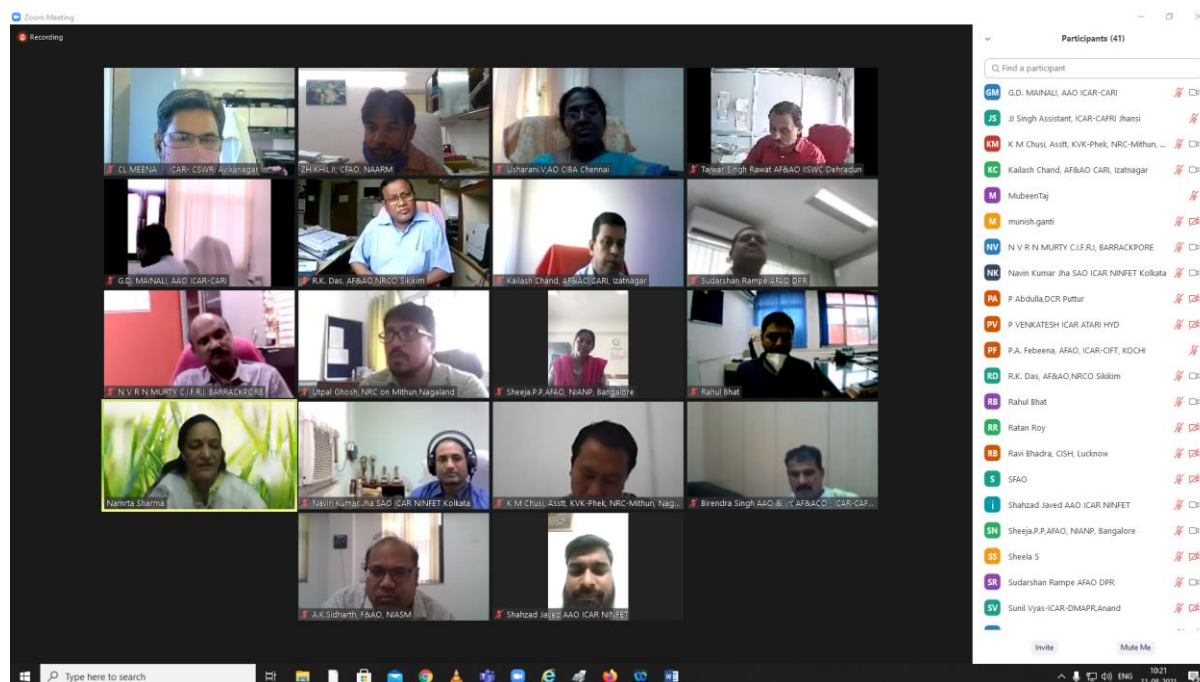
# Virtual Training Program on "BUDGET UTILISATION PROCEDURE" concludes at ICAR-NAARM

11<sup>th</sup> August, 2021

The three -day *Virtual Training Program* on "*Budget Utilisation Procedure*" organized by the ICAR-National Academy of Agricultural Research Management, Hyderabad from 9<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> August, 2021 concluded today. The Training was attended by 42 participants from across the State Universities, KVKs, AICRPs and ICAR Institutes. The participants included from the level of Assistant Professor, CTOs/Head of Offices, Head of Finances, SAO/SF&AO/AO/F&AO/AAO/AF&AO/Assistants.

The focus was on the various aspects of Utilisation of 100% Budget. Topics covered were- Procedure for Budget estimates to its final approval by Parliament, Significance of EFC and its procedures for approval; What if some items are not approved in EFC but to be purchased on urgency?; How to distinguish Capital and Revenue Expenditure, With case studies; Role of DARE in ICAR Finances; Principles and practices of remittance from ICAR/MOF; Synergy for optimum utilisation of Resources among Admn & Finance; How to Resolve conflict in Budget utilisation among Admn/Finance & Scientist; Management strategies for efficient and timely Budget Utilisation.

Katiha , Prinicpal Scientist (PIM) , **Shri GP Sharma, Director(Finance)**, **Ms.Namrta Sharma, Director(Admn)**, ICAR HQ , Shri Suresh Kumar, CAO, CSWRI, Avikanagar and Dr. G. Venkateshwarlu, Joint Director, NAARM made excellent presentations on these subjects.
