Background

Impact Assessment (IA) efforts are critical in management of agricultural research and assume greater significance in the context of limited availability of public funds for research. Assessing the impact of research helps in justifying the investment made and also to plan and prioritize future research programs and activities. Impact assessments are done after research in terms of social and economic benefits and sometimes it is done before or during the research assessing the likely benefits. Understanding the tools and methodological approaches of impact assessment and the complexity in input and output parameters would be useful to the researchers in National Agricultural Research System.

Objectives

- To orient the participants to the necessities and concepts of impact assessment of agricultural research
- To acquaint the participants with techniques/tools and methodological approaches of impact assessment; and
- To discuss empirical studies on impact assessment synthesizing experiences in agricultural and allied sectors.

Content

- Impact assessment in agricultural research –Techniques/Tools/Methods
- Research prioritization, monitoring and evaluation in national agricultural research system
- Empirical studies of impact assessment in agricultural and allied sectors and Knowledge sharing
