

Virtual Training for HRD Nodal Officers of ICAR Concludes at ICAR-NAARM

Three days Competency Enhancement programme on “Effective Implementation of Training Functions” by HRD Nodal Officers of ICAR was organized in online mode during February 21-23, 2022. A total of 63 in-charges of HRD wing of ICAR Institutes including 6 women participated in the training.
