

ICAR-NAARM Organizes Skill Development Training for Rural Women on Backyard Poultry Farming

To enhance the livelihood through income generation by having a self-employment activity to women. ICAR-NAARM organized three days training programme on “Backyard Poultry Farming” under SCSP in collaboration with Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVK), Yagantipalle, AP for SC women from 14th to 16th March 2022. 40 women from three villages viz., Vemulapadu, Kalugotla, Meerapuram of Kurnool district, Andhra Pradesh were trained. The participants were gained both theoretical & practical experience on Poultry Management in the backyards, Diseases commonly observed in Poultry and their management. To start the Backyard Poultry Farming by the trainees to each trainee 30 Rajashri chicks were distributed.

Delivering the valedictory address Dr. M. Balakrishnan, Chairman, Sub-Plan Committee, ICAR-NAARM, briefed the participants about SC Sub plan programme and its implementation and enlightened the trainees towards adopting the Backyard Poultry Farming successfully as an income generation activity.

Smt. Dhanalakshmi, Senior Scientist & Head KVK, in her address highlighted that the backyard poultry farming can boost up family income as it involves low cost investment but gives higher economic returns.
