

Laboratory Assessor's Training Course Concluded at ICAR-NAARM

The Laboratory Assessor's Training Course, organized in collaboration with NBL, New Delhi concluded at ICAR National Academy of Agricultural Research Management, Hyderabad for ICAR Scientists. The programme had witnessed the participation of 24 scientists of 11 ICAR Institutions and one from ICAR Head Quarters. The ICAR has initiated **Laboratory Assessor's Training Course** for its scientists mainly to develop in house pool of assessors such that it facilitates accreditation of ICAR laboratories with international standard i.e. ISO/IEC 17025:2017. The NABL team under the leadership of its Chief Executive Officer organised 5 days training programme from 19-23 December, 2022 at NAARM; which is first in series of 5 such programmes.

Dr Ch Srinivasa Rao president of the inaugural function highlighted the need for accreditation for improving the quality of services to stakeholders. Dr S. B. Barbuddhe, Director, NRC on Meat, Hyderabad was the guest of honour and highlighted the very important concerns with quality and requested all scientists to be aware of these issues and challenges. Mr. N. Venkateswaran, Chief Executive Officer of NABL explained the importance of accreditation in the light of global scenarios.
