Director invited for any suggestions / grievances from the pensioners.


Pensioners expressed no grievance from their side. However, the following points were discussed:

1. Medicines availability at ICAR – NAARM Health Centre {raised by Dr MA Basith}

It was informed that the pensioners may purchase medicines and can claim for reimbursement from office. Essential and emergency medicines will be available at NAARM health centre.

- a. Pensioners also agreed with the fact that reimbursement process for medicines shall be followed.
2. Dr A. Debnath, Pensioner raised the issue of difficulty of filling of forms by SSS / illiterate pensioners
 - a. It was suggested that family members of pensioners may be sensitized about purchasing medicines and submitting the bills to office for reimbursement. Already help is being provided by NAARM staff members for many illiterates / SSS in filling the forms.
 3. Shri PG Kohad requested about his pending TTA bill.
 - a. It was informed that as he has already represented to Council, the office is waiting for directions from SMD.
 4. Recognition of Zoi Hospitals [raised by Dr Debnath]
 - a. It was told that the present letter submitted to office from Zoi Hospitals is valid only till 30.8.2023. it was suggested that a letter may be obtained from Zoi Hospitals with latest recognition by Director of Medical Education, Government of Telangana for taking necessary action by the Academy.
