

Training on Vigilance Perspectives concluded at ICAR-NAARM

To mark the Vigilance Awareness Campaign, ICAR NAARM organized a three-day training programme on 'Vigilance Perspectives for ICAR Officers' from 18-20 October 2023. The programme was attended by 35 Assistant Administrative Officers and Section Officers, representing 32 ICAR institutions and Head Quarters. The primary objective of this training programmes is to sensitize and develop the perspectives of vigilance among functionaries of ICAR institutions.

Dr Ch Srinivasa Rao, Director of NAARM and president of the function categorically indicated that preventive vigilance is utmost important in curbing the corruption. He also cautioned the participants on three important aspects - RPF (Recruitment, Procurement and Finance).

While inaugurating the training programme, Shri Rajeev Lal, Joint Secretary (Admn) emphasised on the need for capacity building of administrative functionaries at the regular intervals and requested to uphold the spirit of the campaign 'Say no to corruption; commit to the Nation'.
