ICAR NAARM organized a three-day training programme on 'Vigilance Perspectives for ICAR Officers', second in series from 1-3 November 2023 as a part of Vigilance Awareness Campaign and Vigilance Awareness Week

The programme was attended by 34 Assistant Administrative Officers representing 31 ICAR institutions spread over 17 states. The primary objective of this training programmes is to sensitize and develop the perspectives of vigilance among functionaries of ICAR institutions.
