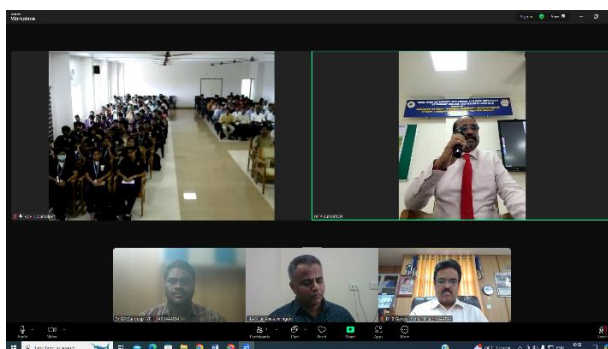


ICAR-NAARM organized Sensitization Programme on Entrepreneurship Development for Students of TANUVAS, Tamil Nadu
