

## ICAR appreciated for securing 2<sup>nd</sup> Rank Nationwide in SADHANA Saptah Learning Drive

The Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) has secured the 2nd position nationwide in terms of total learning hours and course completions during Sadhana Saptah held from April 2–10, 2026. ICAR was conferred the award under the category of “Best Performing Ministries/Departments (10,000 to 50,000 employees)”, recognizing its outstanding performance among large government organizations. The award was presented by the Hon’ble Minister of State (Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions), Dr. Jitendra Singh, during the Valedictory Ceremony of Sadhana Saptah held at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi on April 17, 2026. The award was received on behalf of ICAR by Dr. M. L. Jat, Secretary (DARE) & Director General, ICAR; Dr. S. K. Sharma, ADG (HRM), ICAR; and Dr. Gopal Lal, Director, ICAR-NAARM.
